PERSONAL PROFILE

In 2007, they moved to Maine so Jessica could attend the University of New England, and Van found employment with Contech Engineered Solutions.

At Contech, Van delved deeper into environmentally focused technical fields, gaining extensive knowledge in environmental permitting, the Clean Water Act, and green infrastructure applications. His role involved designing and promoting solutions across the U.S., leading to seven promotions, ultimately becoming the Area Manager for the Central Region.
